A note from our recycling provider, Athens-Hocking Recycling, said that the drivers have noted some contamination in past pick-ups. They are:

1. Foil lined Styrofoam
2. Large bulky plastic
3. Scrap metal (fencing)

WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT

Other recycling tips:

- No half-empty jars or pizza leftovers in the box
- Rinse your recycling - it doesn't have to be completely clean but just rinsed
- Items smaller than a business card can't be sorted and should go into the trash
- Cardboard, aluminum cans, aluminum foil, steel cans and plastic bottles are worth the extra effort it sometimes takes to recycle them.
- Medical waste is NOT recyclable and is dangerous when placed in mixed recycling.
- Batteries, lightbulbs, electronics, books and scrap metal should NOT be placed with the mixed recycling. They can be taken to the Center for Hard to Recycle Materials at 9009 Sand Ridge Road at Route 13 outside Logan.


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Lakes Committee Pontoon Removal Fall 2017

We started the removal at 8:00 a.m. and completed it by 12:30 p.m. We removed 87 boats. Many people have told us that we have a great system for taking out so many boats in a 4 to 5 hour time period. It takes a minimum of 40 volunteers and three HAH maintenance employees to do a pontoon removal.

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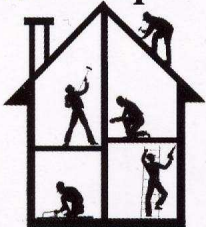
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NEWS FROM THE RANGE

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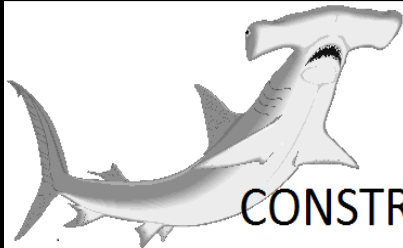

TREASURER'S REPORT – Tom Mathews

Total Committee funds in the Vinton County National Bank on October 31, 2017 were \$75,614.64. Motion to approve made by Tom Mathews; second by Linda Lonsinger – **Motion Carried**

MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT – Chas Cross

- Capital Fund: \$74,118
- Depreciation Fund: \$66,875
- At the last Management Committee meeting, we put together a list of what we would like to accomplish in 2018, we ranked them and I have prioritized them for next year. Top three items: replacing the guard shack, addressing the weather-related damage to the roads and silt pond clean and repair.
- As part of cleaning out the silt pond, we will need to determine what we are going to do with the silt we remove; the consensus from the group was to try to keep it in close proximity to the current area and to protect from going back into the lake with silt fencing.
- The Maintenance Supervisor, Rick O'Neil, attended our last Management Committee meeting to sit down and listen to his concerns and priorities. We will be having Rick and Randall Rose, Security Supervisor, attend meetings occasionally to keep open conversation with them.
- The Lodge front door update, the glass is now back, it is a matter of getting the contractor to install it. Our hope is that he will start on this within the next week.
- I want to look at the potential for us to do something for the employees as appreciation for what they do for us. I am open for suggestions for potential events.

GENERAL MANAGER'S REPORT – Chas Cross

- Delinquency totals: October 16, monthly \$41,807, Roads \$5,418; November 15, monthly \$37,803, Roads \$4,017.
- Dam assessment balance as of November 21st: \$381,168
- Need approval for 2018 Buzzard/Goose depredation permit renewal.
- Load limits are going to be in line with what the county does which will be February 2nd through April 15th.
- We successfully exercised the new gate valve for the principal spillway to start lowering the lake; our goal is to lower it by three feet. It took 63 turns, which will drop it an inch per day which is what we are allowed to do. We will start to address and draw down Lake Eagle Claw starting next week.
- Randy made a trip into Ohio Mulch and they gave us a refund on the unused mulch that AFY Committee did not use, which totaled are around \$750 which went back into the AFY Amenity funds.
- The Clubhouse will be closed on November 29th for carpet cleaning.
- We did an assessment on the Club insurance and changed carriers; we feel we will be provided better coverage and a potential for savings as well.

THE MONTHLY ASSESSMENT RATES HAVE INCREASED

If you pay your assessment through on-line banking or autopay through your bank, please be sure to change the amount to keep your account current.

Effective with the January 2018 assessments, the full assessment was \$160.97 and is now \$164.69, the 1/3 rate was \$53.66 and is now \$54.90, and the 2/3 rate for co-ownership and long-term tenant fees was \$107.32 and is now \$109.80.

Load Limits



Management has set the dates for load limits to begin on February 2, 2018 and last through April 15, 2018. Please plan your construction and/or moving plans accordingly.

General Rule #22
"Load limits will be placed on all roads during inclement weather to prevent damage to the roads. No vehicles in excess of five (5) ton gross weight, will be permitted during such enforcement, except emergency vehicles or any vehicle approved by the General Manager. Penalty for violation of the load limits will be a \$500.00 fine to the member, per occurrence."
